DREAM CATCHER TIPS

- Start with a couple of meters of string.
- Knot or glue on the first string – use a clothes pin to keep string from loosening.
- Make the extra string into a ball or let hang and loop through.
- Keep your string tight as you pull along the hoop and when looping the web.
- Work from the under/inside of the hoop.
- Add beads as you go along or tie on after. Hang beads, feathers or other objects at the base.
