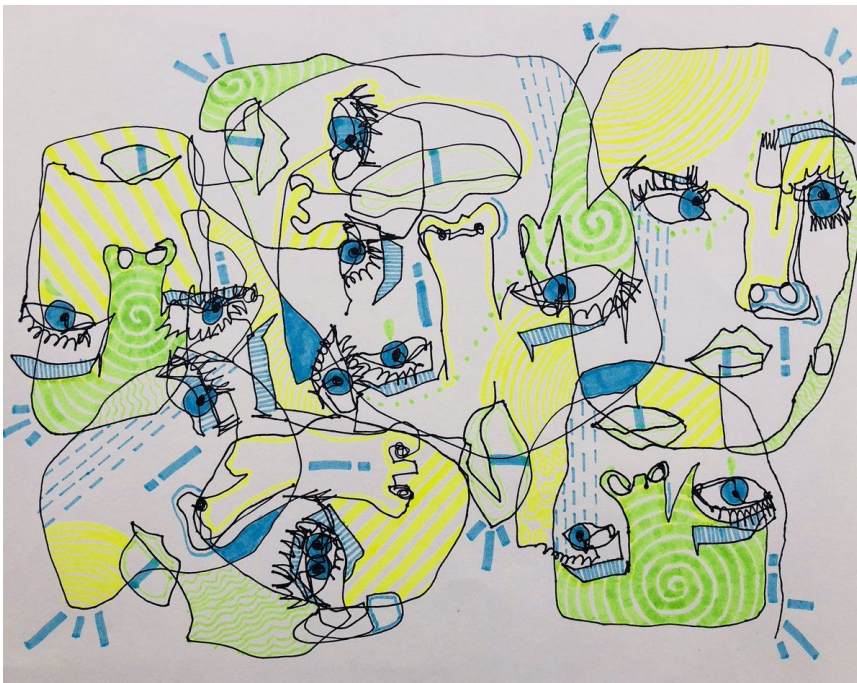
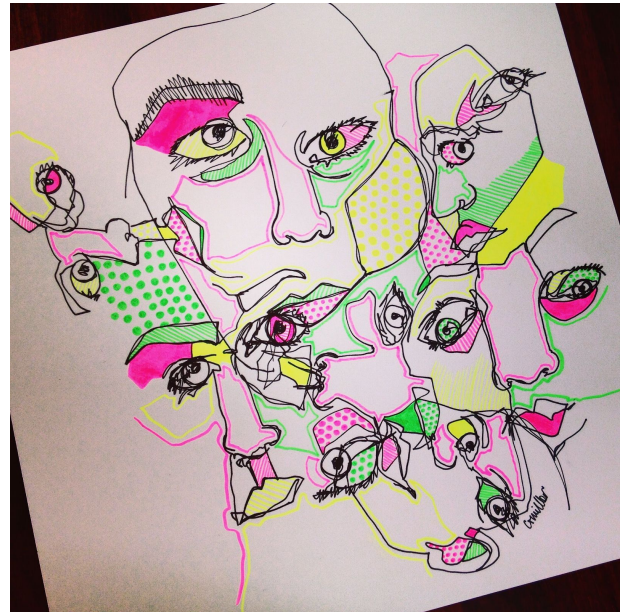
TASK:

Part 1 - Continuous Blind Contour Line Portraits

- Using a black sharpie, partner up with another student and draw a continuous contour line drawing of their face.

Blind Contour Line means looking ONLY at your subject and NOT at the paper. Do NOT let the marker leave the page, the line should just be ONE flowing line. Partner up with another student at least 5 times. All portraits should be on the SAME page.

- Add patterns, lines, outlines, shapes, etc. in some of the negative spaces with highlighter or bright/neon coloured markers.



Part 2 - Continuous Blind Contour Line SELF Portrait

Now YOU get to be the model. Use a mirror, OR a selfie from your phone to create your drawing.

- Using a black sharpie, draw a continuous contour line drawing of your own face. Fill the whole page (no tiny drawings!)

Remember: Look ONLY at your face and NOT at the paper. The marker should NOT leave the page. Shade in some areas with the black sharpie and colour in some negative space with highlighter or bright/neon coloured markers.
