THE SEVEN GRANDFATHER TEACHINGS

Spiritual teachings, or gifts are part of the Anishinaabe tradition and have been adopted by other Nations.

 By practicing these gifts, people bring harmony and balance to their own lives, to their relationships with others, and the land.

HONESTY

X Gwekwaadziwin = Honesty:

X Be honest with yourself and recognize the honesty within others.

HUMILITY

X Dbaadendizin = Humility:

X Be humble and recognize how little you know of the universe.

TRUTH

× Debwewin = Truth:

X Learn truth, live with it, walk with it, and speak it.

WISDOM

Nbwaakaawin = Wisdom:

X Know the difference between good and bad and the result of actions.

LOVE

× Zaagidwin = **Love**:

× Learn to love unconditionally.

RESPECT

× Mnaadendmowin = Respect:

× Show respect for others, their beliefs, and yourself.

BRAVERY

× Aakdehewin = **Bravery**:

× Do the right thing even it can cause pain.
