TURTLE ZENTANGLE MEDICINE WHEEL Pen & Ink Project HRE10

Task: Explore the teachings of the medicine wheel within a turtle motif. Apply types of line and line variations using zentangles and a variety of pen and ink shading techniques in each quadrant of the composition. Incorporate the signs and symbols representative of each quarter of the wheel within your design to reflect the teachings learned in class.


Materials: Paper, ruler, pencil, ink, stylus & nib (or fineliner)


Process:

- 1. <u>Sketchbook</u>: Plan your work. Decide on the symbols and designs you wish to incorporate to reflect the teachings/meaning of the four quadrants of the medicine wheel.
- 2. <u>Good copy</u>: Start with a square piece of paper. Divide your paper into 4 quadrants using a ruler (see photographs).
- 3. Measure equal distances from the centre point outwards to ensure a properly centred & positioned circle. Use a compass or circle tracer and pencil to complete your circle.
- 4. Design a turtle (aerial perspective) using your circle as the turtle shell.
- 5. Outline the contour of your turtle to create a white border
- 6. Fill in each quarter of the turtle shell with designs and symbols that reflect that quarter of the medicine wheel. Fill in the remaining negative space with a variety of zentangles.
- Once all quadrats are complete, fill in the remaining negative space with zentangles.
- 8. Colour the outside negative space (outside the turtle border) with the corresponding colours of the medicine wheel.
